Schedule of Events: This is a totally split day. Competition will commence at **8:30 a.m.** sharp with Primary, Beginner and Novice doing all dances to completion, followed by Awards. Intermediate & Premier will not commence before **11:30 a.m.**

Order of Dance: Morning: Beginner/Novice-Lilt(4); Primary/Beginner/Novice-Fling(4); Primary-Pas de Bas; Pas de Bas/Hi' Cuts; Beginner/Novice/ Primary-Sword(2+1); Beginner/Novice-Sean Triubhas(3+1); **Afternoon:** Intermediate/ Premier - Fling (6); Sword (3 + 1); SeanTriubhas (4+2); Reel .

AWARDS:Most Promising Beginner, Novice & Intermediate dancer. Overall & 1st Runner-up trophies in all categories (except Primary).Awards will be to two places less than dancers entered to a maximum of 6 places. Trophies computed to 6 places.

Competition Rules: Please read carefully,

1-The competition will be governed by the rules of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing. Competitors **MUST SHOW** a current S.O.B.H.D. registration card. 2- There will be **NO REFUNDS**. 3-Entries must be paid by cheque or money order made payable to The Highland Dancers' Association of Ontario. NSF cheques will be subject to an additional \$10.00 fee. 4- One dancer per entry form. Entries must go through Canada Post Regular Mail. Entries that necessitate being picked up at the post office or at a courier will **NOT** be accepted. **NO PHONE ENTRIES** 5- Classes will be divided after all entries have been received. The H.D.A. Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes after the close of entries. 6-Decision of the judge(s) is final. No discussion or correspondence can be entered into between a judge and a competitor or the parent or legal guardian of a competitor regarding any decision made by the judge(s). 7-Any complaint must be in writing with the complainant's signature, accompanied by \$10.00 and given to the H.D.A. Competition Committee (prior to the end of the day) for consideration at the next H.D.A. Executive Meeting. The fee will be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld. 8- Dancers must compete in their appropriate section and will dance in inverse order of entry. Dancers must dance in numerical sequence or be disqualified. 9- Dancers must remain in appropriate costume for awards. 10- **IMPORTANT:** No status (category) changes will be accepted the day of the competition. If status change received before closing date, dancers will be in correct order of entry.
