Order of Dance: Beginner/Novice - Flora (4); **Primary/Beginner/Novice** – Fling (4); **Primary** Pas de Bas; Pas de Bas/Hi’Cuts; **Beginner/Novice/Primary** -Sword (2+1); **Beginner/Novice** - Sean Triubhas (3+1); **Intermediate/Premier** – Jig (3+1 finishing step); Fling (4); Sword (2 + 1); Sean Triubhas (3+1).

Awards: Awards will be to two places less than dancers entered to a maximum of six places. Trophies computed to six places. No trophy in Primary

Competition Rules: Please read carefully,

1-The competition will be governed by the rules of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing. Competitors MUST SHOW a current S.O.B.H.D. registration card. 2-There will be **NO REFUNDS** of entry fees. 3-Entries must be paid by cheque or money order made payable to the **Bracebridge Highland Games**. NSF cheques will be subject to an additional \$10.00 fee. 4-One dancer per entry form. Entries must go through Canada Post Regular Mail. Entries that necessitate being picked up at the post office or at a courier will **NOT** be accepted. 5- Classes will be divided after entries have been received. The H.D.A. Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes after the close of entries. 6-Decision of the judge(s) is final. No discussion or correspondence can be entered into between a judge and a competitor or the parent or legal guardian of a competitor regarding any decision made by the judge(s). 7-Any complaint must be in writing with the complainant’s signature, accompanied by \$10.00 and given to the H.D.A. Competition Committee (prior to the end of the day) for consideration at the next H.D.A. Executive Meeting. The fee will be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld. 8- Dancers must compete in their appropriate section and will dance in inverse order of entry. Dancers must dance in numerical sequence or be disqualified. 9- Dancers must remain in appropriate costume for awards. 10- **IMPORTANT.** No status (category) changes will be accepted the day of the competition. If status changes after entry submitted, please notify rmalodzinski@arrow.com or 905-828-7532-as soon as possible. Last day for status change is Monday, August 16. If status change received before closing date, dancers will be in correct order of entry.
